- DECREE OF DISTRIBUTION -

BELLE B. ENNOR, the Administratrix of the above-entitled Estates, having on the 10th day of September, 1928, rendered and filed herein a full account and report of her administration of said estate, which account was for final settlement, and having with said account filed a petition for final distribution of said estate, and said account and petition coming on regularly this day to be heard, and there having been filed herein the duly acknowledged request of the heirs of said estate that the same be distributed without further notice to them, and they requesting therein that said account be approved and confirmed, and said estate distributed in conformity with said petition for distribution; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that due and legal notice of the hearing of the said account and petition has been given to all persons interested in said estate, and after due and legal evidence having been adduced, and it appearing that said account is true and correct as rendered, and that the costs of administration have been paid by the private funds of the heirs herein, and it appearing that no claims were filed against said estate, and it further appearing that said estate is ready for distribution and in a condition to be closed; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said first and final account of said Administratrix be, and the same hereby is settled, allowed, approved and confirmed as rendered; and

It further appearing to the Court by affidavits of publication and posting that notice to creditors had in all respects been given as by law provided, and that more than three months have elapsed since the first publication thereof;

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that due and legal notice to the creditors of said Sarah P. Ennor, deceased, has been given.

And the Court further finds:

That said Administratrix was duly and legally appointed as such administratrix by an order of the above-entitled Court, made and entered on the 1st day of September, 1927, and thereupon duly qualified as such administratrix, letters of administration being duly issued to her as such administratrix on said date. That ever since said date she has been and now is the duly appointed, qualified and acting administratrix of said estate, and that inventory and appraisement was returned as required by law;

That all the debts of said estate have been paid and the costs of administration paid by the heirs herein, and that said estate is in a condition to be closed and is ready for distribution; that the Administratrix herein has specifically waived her statutory fees and MORLEY GRISWOLD & MILTON J. REINHART have in Open Court stated that arrangements have been made for the payment of the same with the heirs herein, and having waived the setting of fees, herein by the Court.

That all the estate of said deceased is separate property, in that she died a widow;

That said deceased died intestate on the 26th day of October, 1925, at Grand Junction, State of Colorado; that she was a resident of said City and State at the time of her death and she left estate within the Counties of Elko and Eureka, State of Nevada, within the jurisdiction of this Court;

That said deceased left her surviving the following named heirs at law;

Hurburt Burton Ennor, a son, and Belle B. Ennor, a daughter.

That a particular description of the residue of said estate is as follows, to-wit:

An undivided one-half interest in and to the following described real property:

IN TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 52 EAST, M.D.B. & M.,

- Section 5: SE $\frac{1}{4}$;
- Section 8: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$;
- Section 16: W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$;
- Section 17: The whole thereof;

IN TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 52 EAST, M.D.B. & M.,

Section 32: The W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$;

Together with all water rights used upon or in connection with said premises.

Also, all the interest of the deceased herein in and to the following described patented mining claim.

ANDROSA LODE MINING CLAIM, being Patent No. 114542, recorded in Book 1 of Patents, page 317, Records of Elko County, Nevada, on the 18th day of March, 1912;

GLADSTONE LODE MINING CLAIM, being Patent No. 200251, recorded in Book 1 of Patents, page 318, Records of Elko County, Nevada, on the 18th day of March, 1912.

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, all and singular the law and the premises being by the Court fully examined and considered, and all the acts and proceedings of said Administratrix had and taken in the matters set forth upon the records herein, be and the same are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed;

And it appearing to the Court that there is nothing further for the Administratrix to do as such, save and except to deliver the residue of said Estate to the person entitled to receive the same, and HURBURT BURTON ENNOR, the son of said deceased, having filed herein his duly executed and acknowledged assignment of all his interest in said estate to Belle B. Ennor, and his request that the same be so distributed; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that distribution of said Estate now in the hands of said Administratrix be, and the same is, hereby made as follows:

1. To BELLE B. ENNOR, all the rest, residue and remainder of said Estate, a particular description of which is hereinbefore set out, together with any other property not now known or discovered belonging to the Estate, or in which said estate may have an interest.
