THE STATE OF NEVADA

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, George Charles of San Francisco County, California has deposited with the REGISTER OF THE STATE LAND OFFICE at Carson City the STATE TREASURER'S RECEIPT, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said George Charles, according to the provisions of an Act of the Legislature, approved March 12, 1865, entitled "An Act to provide for the selection and sale of lands that have been or may hereafter be granted by the United States of Nevada," and the Acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, for the North East quarter of the South East quarter, the West half of the South East quarter, the South West quarter, and the North East quarter of Section Twenty-eight (28), the North East quarter of the South West quarter, and the South East quarter of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Thirty-six (36) North, Range Fifty (50) East. Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, containing Six Hundred and Forty acres, according to the Official Plat of the survey of the Public Lands, as made by the United States Surveyor-General for the District of Nevada, which said tract has been purchased by the said George Charles.

THEREFORE, KNOW YE, That the State of Nevada, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the Act of the Legislature in such cases made and provided, has given and granted, and by these presents does give and grant unto the said George Charles and to his heirs, the said tract above described, to have and to hold the same, together with all rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said George Charles and to his heirs and assigns, forever; provided, that all mines of gold, silver, copper, lead, cinnabar, and other valuable minerals which may exist in the said tract are hereby expressly reserved.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, EMMET D. BOYLE, Governor of the State of Nevada, have caused these letters to be made patent, and the Great Seal of State to be hereto affixed. Given under my hand at Carson City, the Twenty-seventh day of April, 1917.
