THIS DEED, made September 2, 1930, by CENTRAL PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah, hereinafter called "Vendor", unto SOUTHERN PACIFIC LAND COMPANY, a corporation organized and existingunder the laws of the State of California, hereinafter called "Vendee",

WITNESSETH:

RECITALS

By act of Congress approved July 1, 1862, and by an amendment of such act approved July 2, 1864, and by other acts of Congress amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, there was granted by the United States of America to Central Pacific Reilroad Company of California, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of California, certain lands situated in the States of California, Nevada, Idaho and Utah.

By act of Congress approved March 3, 1865, the assignment made by Central Pacific Railroad Company of California to the Western Pacific Railroad Company of said State, of the right to construct all that portion of said Railroad from the City of San Jose to the City of Sacramento, was ratified and confirmed to the said Western Pacific Railroad Company, with all the privileges and benefits of the several acts of Congress relating thereto.

By another act of Congress approved July 25, 1866, there was granted to the California and Oregon Railroad Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of California certain lands situated in the State of California.

Central Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of California, thereafter on August 22, 1870, became the lawful successor, by consolidation, of the said Central Pacific Railroad Company of California and the said California and Oregon Railroad Company and the said Western Pacific Railroad Company.

On July 29, 1899, the said Central Pacific Railroad Company conveyed to Central Pacific Railway Company all the residue and remainder of the said land grants not theretofore conveyed by the Central Pacific Railroad Company of California, or by the said Western Pacific Railroad Company, or by the said California and Oregon Railroad Company, or by said Central Pacific Railroad Company.

On July 22, 1920, Central Pacific Railroad Company and Central Pacific Railway Company jointly executed, in duplicate, an instrument of further assurance for the purpose of vesting in Central Pacific Railway Company any ownership, right, title, interest, claim or demand of what-soever kind or character in and to any end all property, real, personal, or mixed, which Central Pacific Railroad Company then lawfully or equitably held, or which it might then or thereafter be construed to hold, including all of the lands and land rights enuring under the eforesaid Acts of Congress; therein and thereby Central Pacific Railway Company covenanted and agreed that in all cases wherein Central Pacific Railroad Company was lawfully or equitably obligated to perfect titles in and to Grantees or vendees of itself, or its predecessor companies, Central Pacific Railway Company would make, execute and deliver such deeds or other assurances of title in favor of such grantees or vendees, or the real owners of such property, conveying to them respectively the property or properties to which they might be lawfully entitled.

NOW, THEREFOR, for and in consideration of One Thousand (1,000.00) Dollars and other valuable considerations, receipt whereof is acknowledged, the Vendor does hereby grant and convey unto the Vendee, its successors and assigns, all of the lands and land rights, the property of or enuring to or to endre to the Vendor by firtue of the aforesaid acts of Congress

and by any and all other acts of Congress amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto and wheresoever the same are located in the States of California, Nevada, Idaho and Utah; and also all
rights, titles, estates, interests, claims and demands in respect thereof, at law or in equity,
in possession of expectancy, now existing or hereafter to accrue, pursuant to or by virtue of
the said grants, or either or any part thereof, as well as the right hereafter to receive from
the United States any and all of the said lands and land rights granted as aforesaid, whether
in Primary or Indemnity Limits, or by way of indemnity, together with all the right, title,
interest, estate and claim of the Vendor in and to the said lands and land rights, or any part
thereof, and all the rights of Vendor to apply for and receive patents therefor from the United
States of America; excepting, however, from this conveyance, all lands, land rights, rights of
way, and interests in lands which have, prior to the date hereof, been otherwise conveyed by
the said Central Pacific Railroad Company of California, or by the said Western Pacific Railroad Company, or by the said California and Oregon Railroad Company; or by the said Central
Pacific Railroad Company, or by the Vendor herein.

Also hereby conveying all of Vendor's right, title, interest, and claim in and to any and all outstanding leases, contracts of sale and other contracts and agreements, covering or affecting any of the lands hereby conveyed, and also the right and claim to any and all moneys due or to become due thereunder.

FURTHER EXCEPTING FROM THE FOREGOING CONVEYANCE:

First. A strip of land four hundred (400) feet wide, lying equally on each side of each main tract, side tract, spur, switch and branch line of the railroad and branches thereof of said Vendor, extending from San Jose, California, Northerly and Easterly through the States of California, Nevada, and Utah to Ogden, Utah, as the same are now constructed or located upon, across or adjacent to any of the lands hereby conveyed.

Second. A strip of land two hundred (200) feet wide, lying equally on each side of each main tract, side tract, spur, switch, and branch line of the railroad and branches thereof of the Vendor, extending from Roseville, California, Northerly to the North line of the State of California, as the same are now constructed or located upon, across or adjacent to any of the lands hereby conveyed.

Third. All parts and parcels of said lands which are now used for the operation and maintenance of either of the above described railroads and branches thereof of the Vendor, or for the tracks, yards, depot grounds, buildings, or other structures thereof.

Fourth. The right to use any water naturally rising upon or flowing across any of said lands which has heretofore been appropriated by, and is now being used for the operation of the railroads of the Vendor, and the right (to the extent that the same may heretofore have been exercised by the Vendor) to conduct the same, as well as water rising upon other lands, across any of the lands hereby conveyed, in pipes or aqueducts for the purpose aforesaid, together with the necessary rights of way therefor.

ALSO FURTHER EXCEPTING FROM THE FOREGOING CONVEYANCE THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED TRACTS OF LAND:
The following described land situated in the County of Placer, State of California, to-wit:
All that portion of the Southeast Quarter of Northwest Quarter of Section 25, Township 17
North, Range 13 East, Mount Diable Base & Meridian, lying southerly of a line which is parallel with and distant 200.0 feet southerly from the center line of the main track of Central Pacific Railway Company, containing 5.95 acres, more or less;

Lot 3 of West Half of Northwest Quarter of Section 3, Township 15 North, Range 10 East, Mount Diablo Base & Meridian, containing 0.75 of an acre, more or less;

A strip of land 200.0 feet wide extending across the North Half of the North Half of Section 11, Township 42 North, Range 4 West, Mount Diablo Base & Meridian, lying equally 100.0 feet on each side of the located "K" center line of the Central Pacific Railway Company's proposed railroad from Black Butte Summit to Grass Lake Summit, as staked on the ground in the year 1924, said located "K" center line being described as follows, to-wit:
