JUDGMENT AND DECREE QUIETING TITLE

This cause came on regularly for hearing before the Court without a jury upon the Complaint of plaintiff taken as confessed by the defendants named or referred to as above, by their not appearing, demurring, or answering as provided by law, and their time for appearing, demurring or answering as provided by law having expired, and it appearing to the Court that all defendants have been served in all respects as required by law, and the default of said defendants was duly entered.

Messrs. Cooke & Stoddard appeared on behalf of plaintiff, and thereupon oral and documentary evidence was adduced in support of the allegations of plaintiff's Complaint, and the cause was submitted to the Court for its decision.

Whereupon, the Court made and filed its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law herein and ordered that Judgment and Decree be entered for Plaintiff as prayed for in his Complaint;

WHEREFORE, by reason of the law and the Findings aforesaid, it is by the Court here

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED: That all and singular the various steps, acts and proceedings required by law to vest jurisdiction in this Court as to all of the parties defendants have been duly had and taken, and that this Court has full, complete and perfect jurisdiction of all and singular the defendants and the subject matter and to enter its decree herein; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED: That the defendants above named or referred to have not, nor has either or any of them, any estate, right, title, lien or cloud whatsoever in or to the lode mining claims described in said Complaint and hereinafter more particularly described, or in or to any part thereof, and that said defendants, and each of them, be and they are hereby forever barred from making or asserting any claim whateger in or to said claims or any of them adverse to the plaintiff; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED: That the plaintiff is the owner and entitled to the quiet and peaceable possession of all and singular the said lode mining claims free and clear of any claim or demand of whatsoever kind or character that may at any time hereafter be made by, through or under said defendants, or any of them.
