AGREEMENT BETWEEN KARMERS AND MERCHANTS NATIONAL BANK, EUREKA, NEVADA AND REGIONAL AGRICUTLTURAL CREDIT CORPORATION OF SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH, SUBORDINATE LIENS.

THIS AGREEMENT, Made this 14th. day of January, 1933, by and between Farmers & Merchants

LAKE CITY. UTAH, as Second Party;

## WITNEBSETH:

THAT WHEREAS: Moris Labord of Eureka, State of Nevada, did make and deliver to the First Party a mortgage of mortgages upon certain chattel property, to secure certain obligations of said Moris Labord to the First Party, which said mortgage is recorded as follows:
