THIS AGREEMENT, made this 18th day of May, 1933, by and between the First National Bank of Elko, as First Party; and the REGIONAL AGRICULTURAL CREDIT CORPORATION OF SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH,

as Second Party;

WITNESSETH:

THAT WHEREAS, Vincent Modarelli, Joe Modarelli and H.A. Modarelli, doing business under the style of Modarelli Brothers of Beowawe, Eureka County, State of Nevada, did make and deliver to the rirstParty, a mortgage or mortgages upon certain Chattel property, to secure certain obligation tions of said Modarelli Brothers to the First Party, which said mortgage is recorded as follows:
