Know All men by these Presents: That I, Fritz Walti, of the County of Eureka, State of Nevada, the party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Three thousand seven hundred and seventy and no/100 Dollars lawful money of the United States of America, to it in hand paid to The Eureka Land & Stock Company, a corporation of the County of Eureka, State of Nevada the party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged does by these presents sell unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever:

Seven hundred and fifty-four sheep branded *JC* and earmarked half crop off right ear and underslope in left. Being a lot of them bought of Emil Baumann as lambs, also the Damele Co. both of Eureka County, a lot of them have short ears. And I do for my heirs, executors, and administrators, covenant and agree, to and with the party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
