Notice of Intention to Hold Mining Claims

For the Year Ending July 1, 1935

Wm. J. Mahoney, being first duly sworn, deposes and says: That under and by virtue of the provisions of that certain act of the Congress of the United States, entitled "An Act providing for the suspension of annual assessment work on mining claims held by location in the United States," approved June 13, 1935; which said act suspends annual assessment work on all mining claims in the United States, during the year beginning at 12 o'clock Meridian July 1, 1934, and ending at 12 o'clock Meridian July 1, 1935: PROVIDED, that the provisions of this Act shall not apply in the case of any claimant not entitled to exemption from the payment of a Federal Income tax for the taxable year 1934: AND PROVIDED FURTHER, That such suspension of assessment work shall not apply to more than six lode-mining claims held by the same person, nor to more than twelve lode-mining claims held by the same partnership, association, or corporation: AND PROVIDED FURTHER, That such suspension of assessment work shall not apply to more than six placer-mining claims not to exceed one hundred and twenty acres (in all) held by the same person, nor to more than twelve placer-mining claims not to exceed two hundred and forty acres (in all) held by the same partnership, association, or corporation.

It is the desire and intention of the undersigned to hold the lode mining claims herein (Lode or Placer) described and to suspend the annual assessment work on the same for the year ending at 12 o'clock meridian July 1, 1935;

The mining claims so held and owned by the undersigned are described as follows:

Josephine, Josephine No. 1, Josephine No. 2, and Josephine No. 3, situated ten (10) miles, more or less, north of the Town of Carlin, Nevada, consisting of Barium, Spar and Traventine, located by co-partners Wm. J. Mahoney, Wm. Graven, S. M. Erskine and George T. Salzman. situated in the unknown mining district, County of Eureka, State of Nevada; and more particularly described in the certificates of location of record in the office of the County Recorder of Eureka County, State of Nevada

And the affiant further deposes and says: That they did not pay and is entitled to exemption from the payment of the Federal income tax for the taxable year of 1934.
