NOTE: Not more than six Lode Mining Claims held by the same person, and not more than twelve Lode Mining Claims held by the same partnership, association, or corporation, and not more than six placer Mining Claims, not to exceed more than 120 acres in all held by the same person, and not more than 12 Placer Mining Claims not to exceed 240 acres in all held by the same partnership, association, or corporation may be held under the provisions of the aforesaid public act Number 226 suspending the requirement for the performance of annual labor or making improvements on unpatented Mining Claims as required by law.
