ORDER SETTING APART ESTATE FOR SUPPORT OF SURVIVING WIFE AND MINOR CHILDREN

and it further appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that petitioner is the surviving wife of JOSEPH R. TOGNONI, who died intestate at Eureka, Nevada on February 26, 1936, and was at the time of his death a resident of Eureka County, Nevada, and left estate in said county and in the County of Nye of said State of Nevada, consisting of real and personal property hereinafter described, and that the whole value of said estate in said two counties so left by deceased is such as to render it amendable to this order under the law;
