ORDER DECLARING COMMUNITY PROPERTY DISTRIBUTED TO SURVIVING SPOUSE.

This matter coming regularly to be heard on this 22 day of September, 1936, and it appearing to the court that the clerk has given notice for a period of at least ten days, by posting, and that Andrew C. Dibble was at the time of his death a resident of the county of Eureka, state of Nevada, and that he left an estate in said county and state consisting of real property, and that he died in said county of Eureka, state of Nevada on or about May 23, 1936 intestate, and that he left surviving him Emma E. Dibble, widow of the said Andrew C. Dibble; that all of the real property hereinafter described is community property, the same having been earned and accumulated during the married life of the said decedent, Andrew C. Dibble, and the petitioner, Emma E. Dibble. And all and singular the law and the evidence being fully considered and understood by the court, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the said Andrew C. Dibble, died intestate, and that he left surviving him as his widow the petitioner, Emma E. Dibble, and that the property belong to the said estate is community property; it is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said property described as follows: An undivided one-half interest in the south 115 feet by 200 feet of lot 33, block number 39, and lots numbered 2,3, and 4, in block number 2, all as laid down and delineated upon the official map of the town of Eureka, county of Eureka, state of Nevada, be and the same is hereby adjudged to be the property of the surviving spouse, to-wit: EMMA E. DIBBLE, and without administration.
