he desires to hold the above mentioned claim S

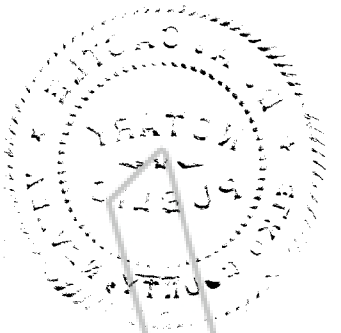
