

# Notice of Intention to Hold Mining Claims

UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SENATE BILL NO S. 187 OF THE 75th CONGRESS

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the undersigned

Further, the said

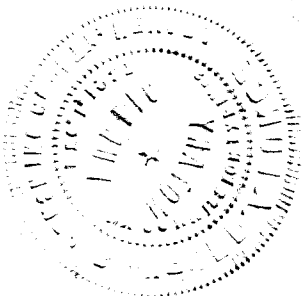

taxable year of 1936 thereby entitling him to hold said claims without the performance of \$100 worth  
of labor or the making of \$100 worth of improvements thereon, as provided in the said act.

NOTE: Not more than six Lode Mining Claims held by the same person, and not more than twelve Lode Mining Claims held by the same partnership, association, or corporation, and not more than six placer Mining Claims, not to exceed 120 acres in all held by the same person, and not more than 12 Placer Mining Claims not to exceed 240 acres in all held by the same partnership, association, or corporation may be held under the provisions of the aforesaid Act Number S. 187 suspending the requirement for the performance of annual labor or making improvements on unpatented Mining Claims as required by law.
