This Agreement made and entered into, this 13th day of October, 1939, Between Isadore Spangler, of 401 Washington Street, Denver, Colorado, and John Clark and Romano Bianchi. Whereas Isadore Spangler, party of the first part, agrees to furnish a compressor, a Jack-hammer, steel, powder, Gasoline and oil, to be used on the Rico, Rico No.1 and Rico No.2 Mining Claims. It is further understood that at the expiration of this lease, or in case the partnership is dissolved that the above mentioned compressor, Jack-Hammer, steel etc returns to the said Isadore Spangler, party of the first part. Party of the first part in Consideration of supplying the above named tools, gas, oil and so forth is to receive 60% of all net earnings of the above named mining claims. The party of the second part agrees to furnish their labor as their port- ion of this contract, Party of the second Part. The party of the first part agrees to pay 60% of all expenses incurred and the party of the second part agrees to pay 40% of expenses incurred in this mining operation.
