The SOUTHERN PACIFIC LAND COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing by virtue of the laws of the State of California, with office and principal place of business at San Francisco, in the State of California, hereby, in accordance with section 321 of Part II of Title III of the Transportation Act of 1940, and the rules and regulations issued thereunder by the Secretary of the Interior, relinquishes, remises and quitclaims to the United States of America any and all claims of whatever description to lands, interests therein, compensation or reimbursement therefor on account of lands or interests granted, claimed to have been granted or claimed should have been granted by any act of the Congress to the SOUTHERN PACIFIC LAND COMPANY or to any predecessor in interest in aid of the construction of any portion of the railroads operated by Southern Pacific Company.

This release does not embrace the rights of way or station grounds of this Company, lands sold by the Company to innocent purchasers for value prior to September 18, 1940, lands embraced in selections made by the Company and approved by the Secretary of the Interior prior to September 18, 1940, or lands which have been patented or certified to the Company or any predecessor in interest in aid of the construction of said railroads.
