NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: That the undersigned, being the owner, or owners, of the mining claims hereinafter described, desire and intend to hold said mining claims under the provisions, and to take the benefit, of that certain enactment of the Congress of the United States known as Public Law 542—77th Congress, Chapter 294—2d Session, H. R. 6604, being an act providing for the suspension of annual assessment work on mining claims during the years beginning at 12 o'clock Meridian, July 1, 1941, and ending at 12 o'clock Meridian, July 1, 1943, under and whereby the provisions of Section 2324 of the Revised Statutes of the United States were and are suspended as to all mining claims in the United States, including the territory of Alaska, during said period, which suspension of assessment work does not apply to more than six lode-mining claims held by the same person, nor to more than twelve lode-mining claims held by the same partnership, association or corporation.
