TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, MARY E. TRAINER of SILVER BOW County, MONTANA has deposited with the REGISTER OF THE STATE LAND OFFICE at Carson City, the STATE TREASURER'S RECEIPT, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said MARY E. TRAINER, according to the provisions of an Act of the Legislature, approved March 12, 1885, entitled "An Act to provide for the selection and sale of lands that have been or may hereafter be granted by the United States to the State of Nevada," and the Acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, for the West half of North East quarter of Section Five (5), Township Twelve (12) North, Range Fifty-six (56) East; the North West quarter of North East quarter of Section Twenty-five (25), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Forty-nine (49) East, and the North East quarter of North West quarter of Section Thirty (30), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Fifty (50) East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, containing One Hundred Fifty-nine and 98/100 acres, according to the Official Plat of the survey of the Public Lands, as made by the United States Surveyor-General for the District of Nevada, which said tract has been purchased by the said Mary E. Trainer.

THEREFORE, KNOW YE, That the State of Nevada, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the Act of the Legislature in such cases made and provided, has given and granted, and by these presents does give and grant unto the said Mary E. Trainer and to her heirs, the said tract above described, to have and to hold the same, together with all rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Mary E. Trainer and to her heirs and assigns, forever; provided, that all mines of gold, silver, copper, lead, cinnabar, and other valuable minerals which may exist in the said tract are hereby expressly reserved.
