

# Notice of Intention to Hold Mining Claims

For the Year Ending July 1, 1943

J. W. Boulware, being first duly sworn, deposes and says: That under and by virtue of the provisions of that certain act of the Congress of the United States, entitled "An Act providing for the suspension of annual assessment work on mining claims held by location in the United States, including the territory of Alaska," approved May 7, 1942; which said act suspends annual assessment work on all mining claims in the United States, during the years beginning at 12:00 o'clock Meridian July 1, 1942, and ending at 12:00 o'clock Meridian July 1, 1943; PROVIDED, That such suspension of assessment work shall not apply to more than six lode-mining claims held by the same person, nor to more than twelve lode-mining claims held by the same partnership, association, or corporation.

It is the desire and intention of the undersigned to hold the 5 mining claims herein described and to suspend the annual assessment work on the same for the year ending at 12:00 o'clock Meridian, July 1, 1942/1943
