KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Wallace Jurey and Art Howell

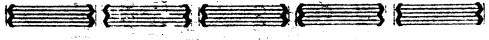
the owners of the following named mining claims known as the Lucky Day No.1, Lucky Day No.II, and Lucky Day No.V

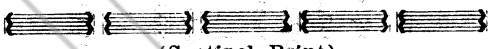
