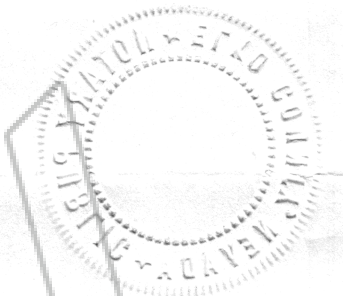

Previous moratoriums have limited the number of claims individuals or joint claimants could hold without performance of assessment work: usually six for individuals and 12 for joint or corporation holding. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT "NOTICE OF OWNERSHIP AND SUSPENSION OF LABOR" FORMS SHOULD BE FILED EACH YEAR.
