DECISIONHighway Right-of-Way Application
Carson City 022840 IDApplication for Highway Right-of-Way Approved.

The Nevada Department of Highways, through the Public Roads Administration, has filed an application, Carson City 022840, under section 17 of the Federal Highway Act of November 9, 1921 (42 Stat. 216; 23 U.S.C. section 18), for a highway right-of-way effecting the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ section 23, T. 19 N., R. 53 E., M.D.M., for Nevada Federal Aid Secondary Project No. S 604.

The application has been examined and found to conform to the regulations. The Geological Survey has reported favorably.

By memorandum of March 18, 1940, approved by the Secretary of the Interior on April 1, 1940, it was held that no charge should be imposed for the use of rights-of-way for Federal Aid Highways.

Pursuant to section 17 of the Act of November 9, 1921, supra, the regulations thereunder (43 C.F.R. secs. 244.42 and 244.44), and the regulations of October 3, 1946 (43 CFR sec. 4.273 (11), 11 F.R., 11816), the right-of-way as shown on the map filed in the District Land Office at Carson City, Nevada, on May 28, 1947, is hereby approved subject to all valid existing rights; but reserving rights-of-way for ditches and canals constructed under the authority of the United States, and further subject to the reservation to the United States of all fissionable source materials pursuant to the Act of August 1, 1946, (60 Stat. 755).

One tracing map showing the location of the right-of-way and the original of this decision are being retained for the files of this Bureau. The duplicate map and a copy hereof are being transmitted to the Manager of the District Land Office at Carson City, Nevada, for appropriate notations and the files of his office. Five copies of this decision are being forwarded to the Public Roads Administration. The Nevada Department of Highways will be advised through the Public Roads Administration, of the action taken.
