notice is hereby given that 2 desire to hold the above mentioned claim S.

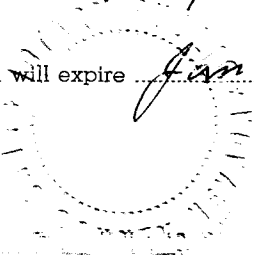
