"President signed mining assessment moratorium bill."

Below is a suggested form that we believe will comply with the provision of this bill (S. 2479) that the claimant "in order to obtain the benefits of this Act shall file, or cause to be filed, in the office where the location notice or certificate is recorded, on or before 12 o'clock meridian of July 1, 1948, a notice of his desire to hold said mining claim under this Act."
