DECISION

Right-of-way Application

Application for Highway Right-of-way Approved.

The State of Nevada Department of Highways through the Public Roads Administration has filed an application, Carson City 022478, under section 17 of the act of November 9, 1921 (42 Stat. 216, 23 U.S.C. sec. 18) for a right-of-way over public lands for a highway extending from a point in sec. 32, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., to a point in the unsurveyed sec. 16, T. 22 N., R. 52 E., M.D.M., Nevada, for Nevada Federal Aid Secondary Project No. S 7 (1).

The application has been examined and found to conform to the regulations. The Geological Survey has reported favorably.

The applicant has filed a stipulation executed May 8, 1946 agreeing to the reservation to the United States of all fissionable source materials in the land pursuant to the act of August 1, 1946, (60 Stat. 755).

By memorandum of March 18, 1940, approved by the Secretary of the Interior on April 1, 1940, it was held that no charge should be imposed for the use of rights-of-way for Federal Aid Highways.

Pursuant to section 17 of the act of November 9, 1921, supra, the regulations thereunder (43 CFR secs. 244.42 and 244.44), and the regulations of October 3, 1946 (43 CFR sec. 4.275 (11), F. R.R. 11816), the right-of-way as shown on the map filed in the District Land Office at Carson City, Nevada on May 3, 1946, is hereby approved, subject to all valid existing rights: but reserving rights-of-way for ditches and canals constructed under the authority of the United States, and further subject to the reservation of all fissionable source materials, pursuant to the act of August 1, 1946 (60 Stat. 755).

One tracing map showing the location of the right-of-way, and the original hereof, will be retained for the files of this Bureau. The duplicate map and a copy hereof are being transmitted to the Manager of the District Land Office, who will make appropriate notations

in his records, of the approval of the right-of-way, and retain the duplicate map and the copy hereof for the files of his office. Four copies of map are being forwarded to the Public Roads Administration, together with four copies hereof. The State of Nevada Department of Highways will be advised through the Public Roads Administration of the action taken.
