Mining Lease

MINING LEASE

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, made and entered into this 7th day of July A.D. 1952, between J. L. Bay and Glen Sharer, Lessor, residents of Eureka, State of Nevada, and W. F. Ewalt of Eureka County, Nevada, Lessee,

W I T N E S S E T H:

That thee Lessor, in consideration of the royalties, rents, covenants and agreements hereinafter reserved and contained, and by the said Lessee to be paid, kept and performed, hereby lease and let unto the said Lessee, all that certain mining property situate, lying and being in the Diamond Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada and described as follows, to-wit:

Diamond Valley Silver and Diamond Valley Silvers 1-2-3-4-5, unpatented and Curtis Keller, Patented.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE said property unto the said Lessee for an indefinite period. The Lessee to pay as royalty ten (10) per cent of the net returns of all ores, whether the same be treated on the ground by smelter or mill, or shipped for reduction or treatment, according to the best judgement of the Lessee, for their mutual benefit. Net returns shall

be construed to mean the returns made by any smelter or reduction plant to which said ores may be shipped after deducting therefrom all expenses paid or incurred by Lessee for transportation and smelting charges. This Royalty to be paid by Lessors until the sum of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000) Dollars has been paid to Lessor at which time the Lessor shall give Quit Claim Deed to Lessee, relinquishing all claims to said Property.

And the said Lessee does hereby covenant and agree as follows:

1. To enter upon said premises and work the same in a proper, minerlike fashion, and in a manner necessary to good and economical mining so as to take out ore with due regard to the safety, preservation and development of said premises as a workable mine. So far as practicable, the property shall be worked in a workman manner.

2. To work said mine with at least 600 shifts of eight hours each and every calendar year.

3. The Lessee shall cause to be posted in a conspicuous place upon said premises, notices of non-responsibility of the Lessor, notifying all persons that the said Lessor will not be responsible or liable for any labor performed, materials furnished or improvements made upon said premises during the term of this lease.

4. To well and sufficiently timber all of the workings on said premises at all points where necessary in accordance with safe mining.

5. The Lessee agrees to notify the Lessor or their agents of all shipments and furnish to the Lessor duplicates of the mill, smelter sampler or reduction works returns.

6. All pipe, rails and buildings placed upon property by Lessee to become part of property and shall not be removed.

7. The Lessee agrees to perform the annual assessment work upon or to file notice of desire to hold the said claim covered by this lease which may be necessary to hold same for the Lessor under the mining laws.
