RIGHT-OF-WAY GRANTED

By application filed August 30, 1955 the State of Nevada, Department of Highways, requested that certain lands be withdrawn from entry as a Maintenance Station, Material and Stockpile Site for Federal Aid Secondary Projects 577 and 602, northwest of Eureka, in Eureka County. The right-of-way requested is depicted on a map dated August 23, 1955 and is designated as the "Pine Valley Maintenance Station, Material and Stockpile Site."

From examination of the records of this office and on the basis of stipulations contained in the map referred to, it appears that the application conforms to existing regulations. Further, the necessary reports have been received recommending favorable action on the subject application.

Accordingly, pursuant to the provisions of Section 17 of the Federal Highway Act approved November 9, 1921 and subject to regulations contained in 43 CFR (Revised) 244 and to all existing rights, the right-of-way, as requested, is hereby granted.

The land requested to be withdrawn consists of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, T. 29 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B. & M. When need or use of the land under consideration no longer exists, this office should be notified referring to the serial number set forth above in order that the records may be noted.
