AGREEMENT EXTENDING TERM OF AGREEMENT DATED JULY 1,1957

- Except as specifically provided herein, Richmond-Eureka waives no rights under said Agreement 2. made as of July 1,1957 or under the Lease or the Agreement, both dated June 30,1937, with William F. James, as each has been amended or modified, and the said Agreement of July1,1957 and said lease and said Agreement, each as heretofore and hereby modified or amended, are hereby ratified and confirmed.
