MATERIAL SITE GRANTED

The State of Nevada, Department of Highways, filed an application on July 7, 1953 under authority of the above-cited Act for a material site to be used as a source of materials for a Federal Aid Highway and said site to encompass the following lands:

(Revised 1954) 244.
