The State of Nevada, Department of Highways, filed an application on August 19, 1954 under authority of the above-cited act for Federal Aid Highway Right-of-way across the following government lands:

T. 32 N., R. 52 E., M.D.Mer., Nevada
 Sec. 30, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$;
 Sec. 20, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$.

The right-of-way is depicted on a map consisting of four sheets which refers to Federal Aid Project No. S 602(8) & S 577(3) described as from 3 miles South of Palisade to 2 miles South of Carlin. The Bureau of Land Management certified the lands described above and shown on the map to be unappropriated public land on August 19, 1954.

The application has been examined and found to conform to existing regulations. The necessary reports have been received.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 17 of the Federal Aid Highway Act of November 9, 1921, the right-of-way as filed is hereby granted subject to:

1. All valid existing rights.
2. Stipulations filed by the applicant and made a part of the application.
3. Central Pacific Railroad Right-of-Way, Nevada 043256, approved December 18, 1903, as to the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 30, T. 32 N., R. 52 E., M.D.Mer., Nevada.
4. Western Pacific Railroad Right-of-Way, Carson City 04038, approved June 15, 1910, as to the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 30 and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 20, T. 32 N., R. 52 E., M.D.Mer., Nevada.
5. All other applicable regulations contained in 43 C.F.R. (Revised 1954) 244.
