MATERIAL SITE GRANTED

The State of Nevada, Department of Highways, filed an application on August 19, 1954 under authority of the above-cited act for a material site to be used as a source of materials for a Federal Aid Highway and said site to encompass the following lands:

T. 32 N., R. 52 E., M.D.Mer., NevadaSec. 20, N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$.

The material site is depicted on a map consisting of one sheet which refers to Federal Aid Project No. S 577 (3). The Bureau of Land management on August 19, 1954 certified the lands described above, and shown on the map, to be unappropriated public land.

The application has been examined and found to conform to existing regulations. The necessary reports have been received.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 17 of the Federal Aid Highway Act of November 9, 1921, the material site is hereby granted subject to: (1) all valid existing rights; (2) stipulations numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 filed by the applicant on the map and made a part of the application; (3) all other applicable regulations contained in 43 C.F.R. (revised 1954) 244.
