RIGHT-OF-WAY GRANTED

The State of Nevada, Department of Highways, filed an application, Nevada-035593, on May 9, 1955, under authority of the above-cited Act, for a Federal Aid Highway material site right-of-way across the following described Government lands:

T. 19 N., R. 51 E., MD Mer., Nevada (Unsurveyed)

A parcel of land 1320 feet wide and 1980 feet long located in unsurveyed portion. The SW corner of surveyed Sec. 19, T. 20 N., R. 52 E., MD Mer., Nevada, bears S.72°10'52"W-- 19,411.18' to the NE corner of said material site, per map.

The right-of-way designated on the map refers to Federal Aid Project No. F002-3, Eureka County. On May 9, 1955, the Bureau of Land Management certified the lands described above and shown on the map, to be unappropriated public lands.

Therefore, pursuant to the above-cited Act, the right-of-way is hereby granted, subject to:

1. All valid existing rights.

2. Stipulations filed by the applicant and made a part of the application.
3. All other applicable regulations contained in 43 CFR (Revised)1954)244.
4. Nevada-043007, Nevada Highway Department right-of-way, approved September 1, 1931.
5. Nevada-030013, Nevada Highway Department material site application.
6. Nevada-035592, Nevada Highway Department material site application.

In accordance with the regulations no charge will be imposed for the use of the right-of-way for Federal Aid Highways.
