RIGHT-OF-WAY GRANTED

The State of Nevada, Department of Highways filed an application, Nevada-035594, on May 9, 1955, under authority of the above-cited Act, for a Federal Aid Highway material site right-of-way across the following described Government lands:

Sec. 15, E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

The right-of-way designated on the map refers to Federal Aid Project No. F002-3, Eureka County. On May 9, 1955, the Bureau of Land Management certified the lands described above and shown on the map to be unappropriated public lands.

The application has been examined and found to conform to existing regulations. The necessary reports have been received.

Therefore, pursuant to the above-cited Act, the right-of-way is hereby granted subject to:

1. All valid existing rights.
2. Stipulations filed by the applicant and made a part of the application.
3. All other applicable regulations contained in 43 CFR (Revised 1954)244.
4. Nevada-043007, Nevada Highway Department right-of-way, Approved September 1, 1931.

In accordance with the regulations no charge will be imposed for the use of the right-of-way for Federal Aid Highways.
