RIGHT-OF-WAY GRANTED

The State of Nevada, Department of Highways, filed an application, Nevada-045026, on February 27, 1957, under authority of the above-cited Act, for a maintenance, material and stock pile site right-of-way across the following described Government lands:

The right-of-way designated on the map consisting of one sheet refers to Federal Aid Project No. 5577 and S602, Eureka County. On February 27, 1957, the Bureau of Land Management certified the lands described above, and shown on the map, to be unappropriated public lands.
