The State of Nevada, Department of Highways, filed an application, Nevada-026790, on July 14, 1954, under authority of the above-cited act for Material Site Right-Of-Way located on Government lands described as follows:

The right-of-way designated on the map submitted as the application, consisting of one sheet, refers to Federal Aid Project No. S 602 in Eureka County, Nevada. On July 14, 1954, the Bureau of Land Management certified the lands described above, and shown on the map, to be unappropriated public lands.

The application has been examined and found to conform to existing regulations. The necessary reports have been received.

Accordingly, pursuant to the provisions of the above-cited act the Material Site Right-Of-Way is hereby granted, subject to:

1. All valid existing rights.
2. Stipulations filed by the applicant and made a part of the application.
3. All other applicable regulations contained in 43 CFR (Revised 1954) 244.

In accordance with the regulations, no rental charge is imposed for the use of the right-of-way for Federal Aid Highways.
