RIGHT-OF-WAY GRANTED

The State of Nevada, Department of Highways, filed an application, Nevada 051913 on March 17, 1959, under authority of the above-cited act for Material Site Right-of-Way located on Government lands described as follows:

The right-of-way designated on the map submitted as the application, consisting of 1 sheet, refers to Federal Aid Project No. F00-2-3 in Eureka County, Nevada. On March 17, 1959, the Bureau of Land Management certified the lands described above, and shown on the map, to be unappropriated public lands.

The application has been examined and found to conform to existing regulations. The necessary reports have been received.

In accordance with the regulations, no rental charge is imposed for the use of the right-of-way for Federal Aid Highways.
