I.

That, in pursuance of said order of sale, he caused notices of the time and place of holding such sale to be posted in three of the most public places in the Town of Eureka, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, in which Town and County the real and personal property ordered to be sold is situated, and to be published in The Eureka Sentinel, a newspaper of general circulation in the said Town and County, for two weeks, being three successive issues of said paper next before such sale, in which Notices the real and personal property to be sold was described with common certainty, all of which will also appear more fully by the affidavits of Joan Shangle and Ira N. That said sale was legally and fairly conducted; that the amount received for the real and personal property is equal to the value placed on same by the appraisers as appears in the Inventory and Appraisement on file herein; and, that the Administrator With The Will Annexed believes the sum thus received is not disproportionate to the value of said property and that a sum exceeding such bid by at least Ten (10%) per cent, exclusive of the expense of a new sale, cannot be obtained.

That the written bids received prior to the date and time of said sale are herewith offered and filed.
