GRANT, BARGAIN AND SALE DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made the 14th day of May, 1963, between JAMES H. GOBBLE, of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, the party of the first part, and JOHN F. SCHWEBLE and LUCILLE F. SCHWEBLE, of Eureka, Nevada, the party(s) of the second part, not as tenants in common, but as joint tennants with the right of survivorship.

W I T N E S S E T H

That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten

(\$10.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said party(s) of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain and sell unto the said party(s) of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns forever, all of those certain lots, pieces and parcels of land situated at and within the town of Eureka, Nevada, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All of Lots Four (4), Five (5), and Six (6), in Block Twenty-eight (28), as the same are delineated and described on the official plat of the town of Eureka, Nevada, on file in the office of the County Recorder of Eureka County, Nevada.

TOGETHER with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the said party(s) of the second part not as tenants in common, but as joint tenants with the right of survivorship, and to their heirs and assigns forever.
