

ASSIGNMENT OF EQUITY IN DEED OF TRUST

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that GLEN MADDOX and PONDA JO MADDOX, his wife, of the County of Eureka, State of Nevada, the Parties of the First Part, for and in consideration of the sum of ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FOUR (\$1, 904. 00) Dollars, and other good and valuable consideration, to them in hand paid by John Stuchlik of Aurora, Nebraska, the Party of the Second Part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said Party of the Second Part, all their right, title and interest in fact or by operation of law, constituting an undivided one-half interest in and to that certain Deed of Trust bearing date the 14th day of June, A. D. 1963, made and executed by R. J. Meter and Bonnie Meter, husband and wife, and Charles R. Poorbaugh and Elizabeth Marie Poorbaugh, husband and wife, all of Beaver, Oklahoma, in favor of Glen Maddox and Edward Siudmak of the County of Eureka, State of Nevada, as Beneficiaries, with the First National Bank of Nevada, Eureka Branch, situate in Eureka, Nevada as Trustee, and given to secure the payment of \$12, 500, which Deed of Trust was recorded on the 18th day of July, 1963 in Book I of Real Mortgages, at Page 411, and given File No. 38476, in the Office of the County Recorder of Eureka County, Nevada, together with the note or notes and all other obligations therein described and the money due and to become due thereon, with interest as therein provided.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Party of the Second Part, his executors, administrators, or assigns, subject only to the provisions in said Deed of Trust contained.
