

Certificate of Location of Lode Mining Claim

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Ante 19 Lode Mining Claim was located by GEORGE H. DILLE, whose post-office address appears below, on the 20 day of December, 1967.

The general course of said lode or vein is Northwesterly & Southerly. The claim is situated in the Lynn Mining District, Eureka, County, State of Nevada, Sec. 5 T. 35N, R. 50E.

The locator claims 750 feet in a North direction and 750 feet in a south direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

From the southwest corner, a monument marked Ante 19 SW Cor., thence in a northerly direction 1500 feet to the northwest corner, a monument marked Ante 19 NW Cor., thence 600 feet in an easterly direction to the north side center, a monument marked NSC, thence _____ feet in an easterly direction to the northeast corner, a monument marked Ante 19 NE Cor., thence 1500 feet in a southerly direction to the southeast corner, a monument marked Ante 19 SE Cor., thence 600 feet in a westerly direction to the south side center, a monument marked SSC, thence _____ feet westerly to the point of beginning.

Each of the above-described monuments is 4" x 4" x 5' wooden stake.
