

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

LODE-QUARTZ

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Wonder Rock Claim lode mining claim was located by Hugo Ostberg Austin Nevada
(print name of locator) (print post office address)

on the 1st day of November, 1963, situated in the Unknown Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada and about 62 Miles from Austin across the fence from the Charnac Basin on the South side of the raseeding area.

We (or I) claim 200 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending _____ feet from the location monument in a Northerly direction, and 1300 feet in a Southerly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a Open pit hole located about 100 feet in a Northerly direction from the location monument, and its dimensions are 6 feet wide, 10 feet long and 4 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a Rock Monument feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the Wonder Rock Claim"; the southwest corner is marked by a Rock Monument feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the Wonder Rock Claim"; the southeast corner is marked by a Rock Monument feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the Wonder Rock Claim"; the northeast corner is marked by a Rock Monument feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the Wonder Rock Claim" There is also a Monument at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since December 20, 1963.
