

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Juniper No. 7  
was located by  
Louis Rossi and Tony Rossi

on the 3<sup>th</sup> day of April 1964, situated in  
Cortez Mining District Eureka County, State of  
Nevada, and about One mile east from the old  
camp of Cortez. This claim joins the  
Juniper No. 1 on the North side.

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)  
This claim is 1500 linear feet along the course of  
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the  
location monument in a North direction, and 750  
feet in a South direction, together with 300 feet  
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim. 1500 feet

The discovery work consists of Open cut  
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)  
situated about 100 feet in a North direction from the location  
monument and its dimensions are 8 feet wide, 4 feet high,  
30 feet long and 4 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4 foot post 4 feet high, inscribed  
"N. W. corner Juniper No. 7 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a  
4 foot post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Juniper No. 7  
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a 4 foot post 4 feet high,  
inscribed "S. E. corner Juniper No. 7 Mine"; the northeast corner is  
marked by a 4 foot post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner  
Juniper No. 7 Mine." There is also a 4 foot post at  
the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since

April 20<sup>th</sup> 1964.
