

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Wild Cat No. 3

was located by

West from the Horse Ranch. This claim joins the Wild Cat claim No. 2 on the South West side and the Weasel claim on the North West end.

claim Blue Mountain linear feet along the course of mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1500 750 feet from the location monument in a N. West direction, and 750 feet in a S. East direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of

cut

(Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 100 feet in a South direction from the location monument and its dimensions are 12 feet wide, 2 feet high, 40 feet long and 3 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed

"N. W. corner Wild Cat No. 3 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a

post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Wild Cat No. 3

Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4 feet high,

inscribed "S. E. corner Wild Cat No. 3 Mine"; the northeast corner is

marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner

Wild Cat No. 3 Mine." There is also a post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since

July 18th 1964.
