

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Blue Mountain
(No. 4) was located by

Louis Rossi

on the 16th day of July 1964, situated in
Cortez District Eureka County, State of

Nevada, and about Three miles North West from the
Horse Ranch. This claim joins the Blue
Mountain claim (No. 6) on the East side
and Blue Mountain claim (No. 1) on the

claim Blue Mountain linear feet along the course of
 mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1500 750 feet from the
 location monument in a North direction, and 750
 feet in a South direction, together with 300 feet
 on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Cut
 (Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 100 feet in a North direction from the location
 monument and its dimensions are 12 feet wide, 2 feet high,
40 feet long and 3 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed
 "N. W. corner Blue Mountain No. 4 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Blue Mountain No. 4
 Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4 feet high,
 inscribed "S. E. corner Blue Mountain No. 4 Mine"; the northeast corner is
 marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Blue Mountain No. 4 Mine." There is also a post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
