

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the
Sniffer No. 60 was located by
Terry Black

on the 5th day of June 19 64, situated in
Secret Canyon Mining District, Eureka County, State of
Nevada, and about 3 1/2 miles Southerly from Prospect Mountain and has
common side lines with Sniffer #59 to the East.

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

I claim 1500 linear feet along the course of
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the
location monument in a Northerly direction, and 750
feet in a Southerly direction, together with 300 feet
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of cut
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 1000 feet in a S 25° W direction from the location
monument and its dimensions are 75 feet wide, — feet high,
26 feet long and 2 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed
"N. W. corner Sniffer No. 60 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
post 4' feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Sniffer No. 60
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4' feet high,
inscribed "S. E. corner Sniffer No. 60 Mine"; the northeast corner is
marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Sniffer No. 60 Mine." There is also a post 4' high at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
