

# Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Sniffer No. 61 was located by Terry Black

on the 6th day of June 1964, situated in Secret Canyon Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and about 2,000' Westerly from Oswego patented and has common side line with Sniffer #40 and common side line with Akerue #2.

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

I claim 1500 linear feet along the course of mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the location monument in a Northerly direction, and 750 feet in a Southerly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of cut (Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 10 feet in a East direction from the location monument and its dimensions are 15 feet wide, — feet high, 26 feet long and 2 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner Sniffer No. 61 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Sniffer No. 61 Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "S. E. corner Sniffer No. 61 Mine"; the northeast corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner Sniffer No. 61 Mine." There is also a post 4' high at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since August 17, 1964.
