

Such labor and improvements so made consisted of not less than 485 feet of exploratory drilling on the Polaris #1 claim.

The above named mining claims comprise a contiguous group of claims owned in common by Atlas Corporation.

Such labor was performed and such improvements were made for the benefit of all of said claims as a part of a common plan of exploration and development and the same tends to improve and develop each of the above named mining claims for which this Affidavit of Work Done is filed.
