

# Certificate of Location

(LODE CLAIM\*)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY THAT the A&D. No. 1 lode mining claim was located by Jackson Mountain Mining Company, whose post office address appears below, on the 25th day of July, 1964.

The general course of said lode or vein is northerly and southerly.

The claim is situated in the Mineral Hill Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, joins the A&D claim to the west.

The locator claims 1400 feet in a (n) northerly direction and 100 feet in a (n) southerly direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows: a cut 4 feet deep, 12 feet wide and 50 feet long located 50 feet east of location marker on claim A&D No. 4.

The total cost of such work consisted of at least \$ 500.00.

The corners and side centers of the claim are located and marked as follows: with posts labeled A&D No. 1 on each corner and one in the center of each side line and each designated NW, NE, SE, SW or side center as applicable

Each of the above-described monuments is a post at least 4 inches in diameter 4½ feet long and set at least 1 foot in the ground

All location and discovery work necessary to complete this location has been performed by October 20, 1964
