Edmond F. Lawrence, first being duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am familiar with those certain contiguous mining claims situate in the Cortez Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada, known and designated as the Nora, Highland Lassie, Norman, Esther B., Helan, Helen No. 1, Helen No. 2, Buddy, Whitsy, and Sheila, and do make this affidavit on the behalf of Ray Nelson, the owner of a undivided one-third interest in the above claims.

For and with respect to the assessment year September 1, 1963, to September 1, 1964, there was performed, or made on, or for the benefit of each of the said claims at least \$100.00 worth of labor, said work having actual value in excess of \$350.00. Such work was done during the period from August 1, 1964, to September 1, 1964,

Such work performed included the following: geologic reconnaissance and geochemical surveys, consisting of areal geologic mapping and soil and rock sampling for geochemical surveys.

The basic findings from such surveys were: (1) although copper, silver, zinc, and lead were somewhat anomalous over small areas, they did not show strong anomalies that might be useful in exploration, (2) mercury was anomalous over the Emma E. ore zone, (3) mercury haloes might be useful in exploration for gold in this area.

Such work was performed by Edmond F. Lawrence, Mining Geologist, at the instance of and at the expense of Ray Nelson, the owner of a undivided one-third interest in said claims, in compliance with the agreement dated June, 1963, between Ray Nelson and Allen and Helen Russell. The work was done for the benefit of Ray Nelson, and entrance on the property was by written permission from Ray Nelson, in accordance with said agreement. Edmond F. Lawrence was assisted in the work by Helen J. Lawrence, and others.

Edmond F. Lawrence is a mining geologist, holding a B. S. degree in geology from the University of Alabama, and with four years of graduate work in geology at the University of California at Los Angeles, and is a Registered Professional Engineer, Nevada No. 1133. His experience includes six years as a mining geologist for the Anaconda Company and the Idaho Maryland Mines Company, six years as a mining geologist with the Nevada Bureau of Mines, and three years as a consulting mining geologist.
