Edmond F. Lawrence, first being duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am familiar with those contiguous mining claims situate in the Cortez Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada, known and designated as the Bull Snake, Blue Mountain, Coyote, Deer, Owl, Porcupine, Red Robin, Sage Hen, Weasel, Wild Cat, Yellow Squirrel, and do make this affidavit on hehalf of Louis Rossi and associates, the owners thereof.

For and with respect to the assessment year September 1, 1963, to September 1, 1964, there was performed, or made on, or for the benefit of, at least \$100.00 worth of labor or improvements, said work and improvements having a total value in excess of \$1,100.00. Such work was done and such improvements made during the periods September 14 to October 17, 1963, and Augustill to September 1, 1964. Such work and improvements were made at the instance of Louis Rossi and at the expense of E. F. Lawrence for the benefit of Louis Rossi and associates, the owners thereof. Some work was performed by Louis Rossi around the campaite.

Such work performed and improvements made included the following viz: road building on the Blue Mountain, Sage Hem, Porcupine, and Weasel glaims, road repairs on the above claims and also on the Bull Snake, Yellow Squirrel, and Wild Cat; several cuts; all cuts and bulldozing being done by HD-16 and D-6 dozers; 7½ days on geological and geochemical surveys consisting of soil sampling for copper, lead; zinc, and mercury determinations, areal geology with emphasis on structure.

The basic findings from such surveys were: (1) copper is anomalous in one area, (2) lead and zinc were essentially negative, (3) mercury was somewhat anomalous throughout the traverses and should be defined by more detail work.

S. degree in geology from the University of Alabama, and with four years of graduate work in geology at the University of California at Los Angeles, and is a Registered Professional Engineer, Geological, Nevada No. 1133. His experiences includes six years with bbe Anaconda Company and the Idaho Maryland Mines Corporation, six years with the the Nevada Bureau of Mines as a mining geologist, and & years as a consulting mining geologist.
