

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

LODE-QUARTZ

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Villanova No. 2 lode mining claim was located by Peter J. Damele EUREKA NEVADA
(print name of locator) (print post office address)

on the 9th day of September, 1964, situated in the UNKNOWN Mining District, EUREKA County, State of NEVADA, and about 7 1/2 miles East of Three Bar Ranch in the head of Meadow Canyon. The North Boundary of Villanova No. 2 is contiguous with the South Boundary of Villanova No. 1

We (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 200 feet from the location monument in a Northerly direction, and 1300 feet in a Southerly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a open cut made on the Villanova No. 1 for the benefit of Villanova No. 2 located about 30 feet in a Northerly direction from the location monument, and its dimensions are 15 feet wide, 20 feet long and 5 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a Juniper Post 5 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the Villanova No. 2 Claim"; the southwest corner is marked by a Juniper Post 5 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the Villanova No. 2 Claim"; the southeast corner is marked by a Juniper Post 5 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the Villanova No. 2 Claim"; the northeast corner is marked by a Juniper Post 5 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the Villanova No. 2 Claim" There is also a Juniper Post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since October 23, 1964
